

# What do you see in this drawing? (focus on descriptive words)

#### Math

How many dollars does Dino the dinosaur have? How many dominos can you count? Is Dino the dinosaur heavy like an elephant or light like a toothbrush?

#### Science

Is it hot or cold in the desert? What would you wear? Can you think of some animals that live in the desert? Can you think of something else that is heavy like a dinosaur?

### **Critical Thinking**

What is Dino the dinosaur doing in the desert?
What would you buy with a dollar?
What would you say to Dino the dinosaur if you could talk to him?
Where do you think Dino the dinosaur is going?

## Wellness (Nutrition, Health, Safety and Social-Emotional)

Why is it important for you to brush your teeth?
What happens if you don't brush your teeth?
Why do we go to the dentist?
What foods are good for you and your teeth? What foods are bad for your teeth?

### **Literacy Activities**

Have students say each word that starts with "D" (Dino, dinosaur, dentist, desert, dollar, domino) while clapping their hands for each syllable; or stomping their feet; or moving their hips side to side.

Ask students for other words that start with "D".

Say two words and have the students repeat them, one that starts with "D" and another one that does not, and then have students identify the word that starts with "D".

Recite the song and omit the words that start with "D" and have students say the missing words. Repeat and have students sign (ASL) the missing words.
